The State Legislature & Veto Power

I pledge to VETO the following legislation if passed by the General Assembly:

1.	Any attempt to raise or extend taxes.	
2.	Any attempt to restrict or oppose school choice.	
3.	Any restrictions on the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights (TABOR), including legislation that uses refunds to reward special interest groups & buy votes.	
4.	Any restrictions on the rights of individuals to have control over their own healthcare choices, including the mandated use of vaccines (specifically in relation to the crimes of the Covid-era).	
5.	Any restriction on the Colorado Open Records Act (CORA), Open Meetings Laws & anything that reduces transparency in our State.	
6.	Any restriction on food freedom including local meat processing, raw milk, cottage food producers and caged egg laws.	
7.	Any attempt to restrict the rights of parents as the sole decision maker for the upbringing of their children.	
8.	Any & all restrictions on the Right to Keep & Bear Arms.	
9.	Any restrictions on the citizen initiative process.	
10.	Any new attempt to add surveillance and revenue generation, including speed/radar cameras & internet (social media) surveillance schemes.	

Executive Actions & State Operations

As Governor, I will operate with the following positions regarding my role as the chief executive of the State:

1.	When given the option, I will appoint Pro-Liberty individuals, who support reducing the role of government in the lives of Coloradans.	
2.	Streamline State operations to limit spending, make a net-reduction in executive rule-making, and decrease the number of employees in the Executive Branch.

4.	Propose a State Budget that creates a net-reduction in spending and is designed to reduce the tax burden on the people of Colorado.	
5.	Limiting the use of emergency powers.	
6.	Preventing the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment from enacting any policies that infringe on the rights of Coloradans.	
7.	Pardon individuals whose constitutional rights have been violated, including Tina Peters.	
8.	Prioritize the investigation of counties & municipalities in which credible evidence exists that corruption or abuse has occurred.	
9.	Audit State Expenditures for fraud, waste and abuse.	
10.	Ensure that permits issued by the State are approved in a timely manner and are not denied for spurious reasons.	

Figurehead Position of Governor & Interstate Diplomacy

As the highest elected position in the State, I'll use my position to be an advocate for the rights of Coloradans, especially with regard to the following:

1.	Promoting Liberty at all levels, specifically around the issues of food freedom, the elimination of the State income tax, promoting Home Rule by counties and municipalities and promoting a free and deregulated market.
2.	At the national level, I will be an advocate for the rights of free people to live voluntarily and push back against any attempt by the Federal Government to restrict the rights of individuals.
3.	Present myself as an example of a strong leader who fulfills his commitments, puts the needs of Colorado ahead of my own, adheres to high ethical standards and demonstrates family values.
As Col	orado's representative to the other states, I pledge to:
1.	Strongly advocate to protect and improve Colorado's water rights.
2.	Protect the Constitutional rights of Coloradans from abuse or infringement by the Federal Government.
3.	Nullify unconstitutional federal laws & regulations under the rights guaranteed by the 10th Amendment to the US Constitution.
4.	Defend Colorado's National Guard by assisting with natural disasters in Colorado and other states, but refrain from deploying the Guard to fight in foreign wars & refuse unconstitutional orders from the Federal Government for Colorado's National Guard.
5.	When agreeing to interstate compacts, ensure that the natural rights of Coloradans are protected, and do not infringe on the natural rights of citizens of other states.
6.	Refuse to extradite individuals who have not infringed on the rights of others, including those accused of committing victimless crimes.
