Jeff Wilson is running for Colorado State House District 7 to represent the Northfield, Montbello, and Green Valley Ranch neighborhoods. A 20-year local resident, Wilson is a retired software engineer and current part-time landlord. Running as a Libertarian, a core pillar of his platform is rebranding the LP as the "Party of Consent", built on individual autonomy and the principle that government exists to protect people, not control them. Under the motto "Liberty Solves Real Problems," Wilson aims to apply these values directly to community needs, including leveraging his landlord experience to shape state housing policy.

Key Issues

- **Expand Affordable Housing:** Streamline permitting and reform zoning laws to make constructing affordable housing easier and faster.
- **Optimize State Spending:** Reduce Colorado's general fund expenditures without cutting services by utilizing Public-Private Partnerships and user-fee models.
- **Decriminalize Sex Work:** Decriminalize prostitution by following successful global models to improve safety, protect workers, and allow them to report crimes without fear of arrest.
